

ZIMBABWE

ACT

To apply a sum of money for the service of Zimbabwe during the year ending on the 31st December, 2018.

ENACTED by the Parliament and the President of Zimbabwe.

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (2018) Act, 2018.

2 Interpretation

In this Act-

- "Estimates of Expenditure" means the Estimates of Expenditure for the year ending on the 31st December, 2018, submitted to and passed by the National Assembly;
- "Retention Fund" means a Retention Fund referred to in section 18(1)(a) or (b) of the Public Finance Management Act [Chapter 22:19] (No. 11 of 2009);
- "Vote" means a vote appropriation for the year ending on the 31st December, 2018, as specified in the Estimates of Expenditure.

3 Consolidated Revenue Fund charged with US\$4 607 896 000

The Consolidated Revenue Fund is hereby charged with such sums of money as may be required for the service of Zimbabwe during the year ending on the 31st December, 2018, not exceeding in aggregate the sum of four billion six hundred and seven million eight hundred and ninety-six thousand United States dollars.

4 Retention Funds charged with US\$412 566 000

The Retention Funds are hereby charged with such sums of money as may be required for the service of Zimbabwe during the year ending on the 31st December, 2018, not exceeding in aggregate the sum of four hundred and twelve million five hundred and sixty-six thousand United States dollars.

5 Application of moneys granted

Subject to section 17(5) of the Public Finance Management Act [Chapter 22:19] (No. 11 of 2009), the moneys appropriated shall be applied to the services detailed in the Schedule and more particularly specified in the Estimates of Expenditure.

6 Power of Minister of Finance and Economic Development to authorise transfers between Votes

- (1) Where, in the case of any moneys appropriated by section 3 or 4 in respect of a particular Vote set out in the Schedule which are to be applied in terms of section 5 to any particular service specified in the Estimates of Expenditure, the administration or provision of such service is assigned to a different Ministry, the Minister of Finance and Economic Development may direct that any portion of the moneys appropriated in respect of the first-mentioned Vote be transferred to such other Vote as relates to the Ministry to which the administration or provision of the service concerned has been assigned.
- (2) In the case of moneys appropriated by section 3 or 4 in respect of subhead LE Unallocated Reserve of Vote 5, the Minister of Finance and Economic Development may direct that any of the moneys so appropriated be transferred to the Vote of any other Ministry for the purpose concerned, and any moneys so transferred shall not be applied for any other purpose:

Provided that, if any moneys so transferred are not required for the purpose concerned, the Minister of Finance and Economic Development may direct the transfer of the moneys back to subhead L.F. Unallocated Reserve of Vote 5.

(3) Moneys transferred in terms of subsections (1) and (2) shall be accounted for as if they had been appropriated by section 5 to the Vote to which they are so transferred, and shall be deemed to have been so appropriated.

SCHEDULE (Section 4)

EXPENDITURE TO BE DEFRAYED FROM CONSOLIDATED REVENUE FUND AND RETENTION FUNDS

(Explanatory Note on Vote 7)

The amount of the appropriation in Sub-Vote 1 of Vote 7 is a correction of the corresponding figure appearing in the Estimates of Expenditure. In the Estimates, the amount of US916 000 under the heading "Capital Expenditure" for the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Enterprise Development is wrongly classified under the column "Retention Funds" (being reflected as an acquisition of fixed capital assets), instead of being included under the column "Statutory and Other Resources" (as Capital Transfers). Resultantly, the Total Appropriation for Vote 7 should be US\$30 507 000 instead of US\$31 423 000 as incorrectly shown in the Estimates.
