## Applications in Connexion with Road Service Permits

**CIVIL SERVICE LAW AND MAGISTRATES ADMISSION EXAMINATIONS**

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Civil Service Law and Magistrates Admission Examinations Notice, 1981.

(2) This notice shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1982.

2. (1) It is hereby notified that the Civil Service Law Examinations and Magistrates Admission Examinations for persons who are employed by the State, or who are authorized to write such examinations by the Secretary for Justice and Constitutional Affairs, are conducted by the Government of Zimbabwe. Two examinations are available—

- (a) the Civil Service Law Examination, which consists of a Preliminary and a Final examination, each part being set twice annually;
- (b) the Magistrates Admission Examination, which consists of one examination, which is set twice annually.

(2) The syllabuses for the examinations shall be as set out in the First and Second Schedules.

(3) All examinations will be held between the 1st March and the 31st March and between the 1st September and the 30th September of each year.

(4) The closing-date for entry for the above examinations in each year are the 31st January and the 31st July.

(5) Unless otherwise stated, one three-hour paper shall be set for each subject in all examinations.

3. (1) Fees payable by candidates for registration and examination are as follows—

(2) In the case of any candidate who is absent from the whole of the examination for which the fee was paid, the examination fee (but not the registration fee) may be refunded upon application made to the Examinations Officer, Ministry of Education and Culture, P.O. Box 8024, Causeway.

Provided that no refund will be made unless the applicant satisfies the Examinations Officer that his absence was due to circumstances beyond his control.

4. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (6), before entering for the Final Examination of the Civil Service Law Examination, a candidate must pass the Preliminary Examination or an examination approved by the examiners as being equivalent thereto.

(2) No certificate shall be issued for passing the Preliminary Examination of the Civil Service Law Examination.

(3) In the Preliminary and Final examinations of the Civil Service Law Examination, an equal number of marks shall be assigned to each paper, and the standard for a pass in each examination shall be forty per centum of the marks in each subject and an aggregate of fifty per centum of the total marks.

(4) The standard for a pass in the Magistrates Admission Examination shall be fifty per centum of the marks in each subject.

(5) Subject to the provisions of subsection (6), no candidate may enter for the Magistrates Admission Examination unless he has passed both the Preliminary and the Final examinations of the Civil Service Law Examination, or an examination approved by the examiners as being equivalent thereto.

(6) The examiners may, in special circumstances in a particular case, and subject to appropriate conditions, to be specified by them, permit a candidate to write part of the Preliminary Examination of the Civil Service Law Examination at the same time as he writes the Final Examination, or to write part of the Civil Service Law Examination at the same time as he writes the Magistrates Admission Examination.

5. (1) A candidate who fails to reach the required standard in one subject only of any examination may, at the discretion of the examiners, be credited with the subjects in which he has passed, and be permitted to present himself for re-examination in the remaining subject alone.

(2) The examiners shall only credit a candidate in terms of subsection (1) if, in their opinion, the standards attained in the papers written merit such concession.

(3) If, on the second occasion, such candidate again fails to reach the required standard, he shall be deemed to have failed the relevant examination as a whole, and shall be



required, on any subsequent occasion, to take the whole examination again.

(4) A candidate who is absent from the whole or part of any examination through illness or other good cause shown, may apply to write such subjects as he was unable to write previously as supplementary subjects, and the acceptance or rejection of any such application shall be at the discretion of the Examinations Officer.

(5) A candidate who is permitted to write a supplementary subject examination shall be notified by the Examinations Officer that he is so permitted.

(6) No special examination shall be set in respect of any supplementary subject or subjects, as the case may be, which a candidate may be permitted to write, and the candidate concerned shall write the examination in respect of the supplementary subject or subjects, as the case may be, at the normal time of the holding of the examination in terms of subsection (3) of section 2.

(7) No fee shall be payable in respect of any supplementary examination permitted to be written in terms of subsection (4), but a fee of \$1 for registration and a fee of \$5 for examination shall be payable in respect of any supplementary examination permitted to be written in terms of subsection (1).

## Conditions for Acceptance of Copy

FAILURE to comply with any of the following conditions will result in the rejection of copy, and no responsibility can be accepted if such rejection should affect any date contained in such copy or any requirement of publication on a specific date.

Persons drafting any kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in—

- (a) the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- (b) the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of Copy, published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.



(3) Computer print-outs are not accepted automatically, as discussion may be necessary with regard to the extra time and costs involved.

2. (1) All copy must be clear and legible, and there must be double or one and a half spacing between the lines.

(2) Any corrections or alterations made by the originator must be clearly effected in blue or black ink, using editorial marks—not proof-reader's marks:

Provided that any copy containing extensive alterations will be rejected.

3. (1) Copy must appear on one side only of each sheet of paper.

(2) Except as is provided in subsection (2) of section 8, paper must not exceed 210 millimetres in width.

(3) If copy comprises two or more sheets of paper, all sheets must be numbered consecutively, in arabic figures, preferably in the top right-hand corner.

(4) Where any matter is added after the copy has been prepared, and such additional matter results in one or more sheets being inserted between those already numbered, all sheets must be renumbered from there onwards—not, for instance, 7, 7a, 7b, 8, et cetera.

4. Photographic copy or copy produced on a duplicating-machine may be accepted if it is abundantly clear.

5. (1) Should any copy—

- (a) exceed 10 pages of typing on A4 paper; or
- (b) contain tabular or other matter which involves complicated setting;

it will be classed as "lengthy" copy, and will be required to be submitted not less than 21 days before the date of closing for the *Gazette* in which it is to be published.
