STATE LOTTERIES ACT [CHAPTER 317]

One Hundred and Eighty-third State Lottery: Units One, Two, Three and Four

NOTICE is hereby given, for general information, that units one, two, three and four of the one hundred and eighty-third lottery will be drawn in public, under the direction of the Minister of Finance, at the venues stated below:

Unit one—13th May, 1988—12.30 p.m., State Lotteries Hall, Harare.

Unit two-10th June, 1988-12.30 p.m., Large City Hall, Bulawayo.

Unit three—8th July, 1988—12.30 p.m., State Lotteries Hall, Harare.

Unit four—5th August, 1988—12.30 p.m., State Lotteries Hall, Harare.

The first prize will be \$50 000 in all units.

Condition for each unit

- (a) Tickets with counterfoils will be sold at \$2 each.
- (b) Based on the face value of all tickets sold or issued free, up to 25 per cent. of the total subscriptions may be reserved for social service, public welfare or relief of distress.

2. Prizes

The prize fund will be distributed as follows-

- (i) Ordinary prizes; first as above; second, \$15000; third, \$7 500. Introducers: \$1 000; \$500; \$250.
- (ii) The remainder of the prize-money will be distributed in smaller ordinary, introducers', introducers' jackpot and consolation prizes. If, in the opinion of the Minister, the prize fund is insufficient for the purpose, the amounts of the first three prizes listed above will be reduced as directed by that Minister.
- (iii) Two introducers' jack pot prizes of \$50 each

Only tickets issued against one written order for 12 tickets in one unit are eligible to win these prizes, provided such written order has been compiled at one and the same time. Prizes not won will be carried forward and used to increase the jackpot prizes in the following unit. These prizes will be drawn after the draw for ordinary prizes has been completed.

3. Double and treble prizes

Any ordinary lottery prize of \$200 or less, won by a lottery ticket will be (i) doubled if the prize-winner sends in with his prize ticket, three additional lottery tickets in the same unit; or (ii) trebled if the prize-winner sends in with his prize ticket, seven additional lottery tickets in the same unit, provided that in order to qualify for the double and treble prize, the counterfoils of all tickets submitted must have exactly the same name and address as that found on the counterfoil of the prize-winning ticket. (Nearly the same is not sufficient.) To give examples of possible differences in the counterfoils: "J. Jones", "John Jones" and "Mr. J. Jones" "Byo" and "Bulawayo"; "Rd." and "Road" and "Box" and "P.O. Box". Multiple prizes do not apply to introducers' prizes and consolation prizes.

4. The draw

The number of all tickets sold will participate in the

draw for all prizes.

If the Director is satisfied that a fault has occurred in the drawing of a prize number, a "no draw" shall be announced and the prize shall be drawn again. A ball jamming when coming out of a drum will not in itself be considered as a fault. Examples of faults—

- (i) one or more balls appearing before control button is pressed;
- (ii) control button pressed before all balls are in the drums.
- Subject to the provisions of the State Lotteries Act [Chapter 317], when a prize-number has been passed and recorded, no subsequent claim that a "no draw" should have been announced will be considered.

- (e) Only the lucky names and towns of the purchasers of winning tickets will be announced, names are not announced or published. (This does not apply to winners of special prizes given to promote the lottery.)

5. Payment of prizes

- (a) All cash prizes are free from taxation by the Government and are payable in full, by cheque.
- Tickets are official receipts in themselves and prizes will be paid out on production of the winning ticket. The Minister may authorize payment of a prize won by a lottery ticket, without production of the ticket.
- (c) If a syndicate wins a prize, it must nominate one or two members to whom the cheque is to be made payable on behalf of the syndicate.

- (3) If copy comprises two or more sheets of paper, all sheets must be numbered consecutively, in arabic figures, preferably in the top right-hand corner.
- (4) Where any matter is added after the copy has been prepared, and such additional matter results in one or more sheets being inserted between those already numbered, all sheets must be renumbered from there onwards—not, for instance, 7, 7a, 7b, 8, et cetera.

SHERIFF'S SALES

Conditions of sale

- 1. The sale is conducted in terms of the rules of the High Court, which provide that it shall be without reserve but subject to the condition that the Sheriff requires to be satisfied that the highest price offered is reasonable, having regard to the circumstances of time and place and the state of the property.
