PREQUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS

The Republic of Zimbabwe has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), the World Bank, in various currencies towards the cost of the Second Family Health Project (SFHP), and it is intended that a portion of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for construction works for which this invitation to prequalify is issued.

The Ministry of Public Construction and National Housing (MPCNH), the Employer, through the Government Tender Board (GTB), intends to prequalify eligible contractors for the construction work under this project as described below, and now invites applications for prequalification from eligible contractors.

The proposed works will comprise the upgrading of eight existing hospitals and the construction of seven new district hospitals, staff housing and related site works. The fifteen hospitals range in size from forty to one hundred and six beds. For tender and contract purposes these works are to be divided into four lots of approximately equal size. Contractors from eligible source countries as defined under the Guidelines of the World Bank for Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits, are invited to prequalify to tender for construction of one or more Lots.

Prequalification documents giving further details of the project requirements and the basis of prequalification, will be available for collection or posting between 09:00 and 12:00 hours on and after 16th January, 1993, and may be obtained upon payment by the applicant of a non-refundable fee of US \$25 (twenty-five US dollars), or equivalent Zimbabwe dollars (Z\$), for each set of documents. Declaration Making Lawful the Carriage or Haulage of Goods for Hire or Reward
