GOLD TRADE ACT [CHAPTER 21:03]

Confiscated Gold

IT is hereby notified, in terms of section 272 of the Gold Trade Act [Chapter 21:03], that the gold described in the Schedule which has been forfeited to the State, is in possession of the Ministry of Mines and Mining Development.

The gold may, by prior arrangement, be inspected by a person claiming a legal right to the gold at the Ministry of Mines and Mining Development, Fifth Floor, ZIMRE Building, Kwame Nkrumah Avenue/Leopold Takawira Street, Harare, during the two months following the date of publication of this notice.

Any person claiming a legal right to any of this gold may apply, in writing, within two months from the date of publication of this notice, to the Secretary for Mines and Mining Development, Private Bag 7709, Causeway, for delivery to him or her of such gold.

If no such person establishes a legal right to any of this gold within the afore-mentioned period, it may be disposed of by the Secretary for Mines and Mining Development.
