COMPETITION ACT [CHAPTER 14:28]

Notice of Proposed Amendment of Order in terms of Section 31(5) of the Competition Act [Chapter 14:28]

IT is hereby notified that Competition and Tariff Commission (hereinafter referred to as the "Commission"), in terms of section 31(5) of the Competition Act [Chapter 14:28], intends to amend its Order against the Cotton Ginners Association of Zimbabwe in terms of section 31(6) of the said Act.

In terms of Order HC 1655/14, the Commission ordered that members of the Cotton Ginners Association of Zimbabwe forthwith cease and desist from engaging in the restrictive practice of setting uniform prices for seed cotton bought from farmers, and that the members individually negotiate such prices with their contracted farmers.

The Commission also ordered that the Cotton Ginners Association of Zimbabwe desists from recommending to its members prices for inputs given to contracted farmers, and prices of seed cotton offered to cotton farmers.

The Commission at the 59th Ordinary Meeting held on the 10th of December, 2014, resolved to amend its order in terms of section 31(6) and the broad terms of the proposed amended order are as follows:

- the ginners individually negotiate with contracted farmers on a seasonal pool price for seed cotton at the beginning of the cotton marketing season; and
- that ginners adjust the price of seed cotton after selling lint and all the by-products of cotton seed at the end of the cotton marketing season.

During the past few months or so there have been many cases where urgent copy for subsidiary legislation, which requires the signature of the President or a minister to give it effect, and which is of national importance, has been sent in for publication in the *Gazette* after closing-time. Whilst I acknowledge that it is the duty of Printflow (Private) Limited to give certain notices special treatment, I am, however, of the view that a *Gazette* Extraordinary has tended to be a must rather than a matter of priority in respect of unwarranted delays of urgent copy.

While every effort will continue to be made to publish Extraordinaries on the required dates, copy must be submitted timeously so that it can be programmed into the printing-work-flow as soon as it is available.
