IT is hereby notified that His Excellency the President has, in terms of section 2 of the Exchange Control Act [Chapter 22:05], made the following regulations:—

Title

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Exchange Control (Exclusive Use of Zimbabwe Dollar for Domestic Transactions) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020 (No. 4).
- 2. Section4of the Exchange Control (Exclusive Use ofZimbabwe Dollar for Domestic Transactions) Regulations, 2019, published in Statutory Instrument 212 of 2019 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal regulations"), is amended by the repeal of paragraph (f) and the substitution of the following—
 - "(f) transactions referred to in sections 5 and 6.".
- 3. The principal regulations are amended by the insertion of the following section after section 5—
 - "Payment of pension contributions and benefits and payment of insurance premiums and settlement of insurance claims
 - 6. (1) Notwithstanding these regulations, it shall be permissible to charge and to tender foreign currency in payment for the following transactions
 - (a) international travel insurance:
 - (b) motor insurance for vehicles in transit;
 - (c) customs bond insurance;
 - (d) bank cash in transit;
 - (e) third party motor insurance payments for foreign registered vehicles;
 - (f) safari operators insurance;
 - (g) export credit insurance;
 - (h) importers and exporters oncost, insurance and freight;
 - (i) exporters' insurance, including mining houses and tobacco merchants;

Exchange Control (Exclusive Use of Zimbabwe Dollar for Domestic Transactions) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020 (No. 4)

- special insurance policies for strategic national assets, including electricity equipment and stations, and aircraft equipment;
- (k) insurance policies, where—
 - payment of insurance premiums is made by entities or individuals with free funds; or
 - (ii) insurance premiums are paid offshore; or
 - (iii) payment of insurance premiums is made by entities or individuals otherwise authorised to trade in foreign currency;
- payments of pension orprovidentfunds contributions to pensions or provident funds, by any entity approved by a legal instrument to settle local contracts or pay local employee remuneration in foreign currency.
- (2) Pension or provident funds that receive contributions in foreign currency in terms of this section, shall—
 - invest the contributions in investment instruments denominated in the same currency the contributions are made; and
 - (b) in respect of fund members whose contributions have been paid in foreign currency, through Nostro-Accounts, pay such member's be ne lits in the currency in which the contribution has been paid.
- (3) Where Insurers receive premiums in foreign currency in respect of a policy of insurance in terms of these regulations, obligations to policyholders arising therefrom shall also be settled in the currency in which the premiums have been received.".

- 2. The Radiation Protection (Safety and Security of Radiation Sources) Regulations, 2011, published in Statutory Instrument 62 of 2011 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations) are amended by the insertion after section 35 of the following sections —

"Declaration of inspection for radiation contamination of vehicles

- 35A. (1) Further to the section 16 ("Prohibition of importation or exportation except through appointed ports or by defined routes") of the Customs and Excise Act [Chapter 2 3:02] any person wishing to import a vehicle into Zimbabwe directly or indirectly from a country that experienced a level 2 and above incident on the International Nuclear and Radiological Event Scale specified in the Fifth Schedule must make a declaration in Form RP1 ("declaration of inspectionfor radiation contamination of vehicles") at the port of entry, stating where the vehicle is being imported from, and subject it to radiation contamination inspection by the authority upon payment of the prescribed fee.
- (2) The Authority shall, after receiving the declaration referred to in subsection (1)
 - satisfy itselfthatFormRPl ("declaration of inspection for radiation contamination of vehicles") has been properly completed;
 - (b) immediately conduct the necessary test for radiation contamination on the vehicle.
- (3) If a vehicle is found to have a surface dose rate measurement of more than I .OpSv per hour it shall be deemed to be contaminated, and the Authority shall proceed to de-contaminate the vehicle upon payment of the prescribed fee by the person responsible for importing the vehicle.

Radiation Protection (Safety and Security of Radiation Sources) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020 (No. 5)

(6) Any person who does not comply with subsection (1) or who makes a false statement or declaration or falsi lies any documents concerning the country of origin of a vehicle shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a hue not exceeding level 5 or imprisonment for a period not exceeding six month or both such hue and such imprisonment.

Issuance of certificate of non-contamination

35B. If upon inspection of radiation contamination—

- (a) a vehicle is found to be free of radiation contamination;
- (b) a contaminated vehicle is successfully de-contaminated by the Authority;

the Authority shall issue to the person wishing to import a vehicle a certilicate of non-contamination in **Form RP2** ("Certificate of non-contamination") and make an appropriate entry in the register.

Conditions attaching to every certificate

- 35C. (1) It shall be deemed to be a condition of every certificate of non-contamination that no certificate issued to a specific vehicle shall be used as evidence of radiation contamination inspection for another vehicle.
- (2) Any person who contravenes subsection (1) shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 or imprisonment for a period not exceeding one month or both such fine and such imprisonment.

Register of certificates of non-contamination

- 35D. (1) The Authority shall establish and maintain a register of certificates to be known as a Certificates of Non-Contamination Register, in which the following shall be recorded—
 - (a) the name and address of the importer; and
 - (b) details of the vehicle including the country of origin, make, model and year of manufacture of the vehicle.

S.I. 281 of 2020

- (2) Any person may—
- (a) inspect the register at all reasonable times at the premises of the Authority or at such other place that the Authority may direct; or
- (b) obtain copies of or extracts from the register for a prescribed fee.
- (3) The Authority shall keep and maintain the register in both material and electronic form.
- 3. The principal regulations are amended in the Third Schedule by the insertion of the following—
