ZINARA currently operates 31 tollgates on the major highways of Zimbabwe. The amount of traffic in recent years has increased due to the increasing number of vehicles. Every day, thousands of people use their vehicles on the country's highways. The increasing number of vehicles on the roads, result into many problems such as long queues, delays, congestion, air pollution and fuel wastage. The payment methods that are in operation at the toll plazas depend on the network communication systems operated by the Mobile Network Operators and the Point-of-Sale machines from the banks and these payment methods have inherent delays and are not capable of coping with the increased traffic volumes. The current payment procedure can be slow, which often results in traffic jams at the toll plazas on busy highways.

The above challenges have created a huge negative implication on revenue collection and has created a nightmare for the motoring public. To curtail the challenges, ZINARA wishes to introduce an Electronic Toll Collection (ETC) system using Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) technology at the tolling points on the Zimbabwe highways.

ZINARA hereby invites local and international eligible/qualified solution providers/firms to express their interest in the supply, installation, configuration, and commissioning of an Electronic Toll Collection (ETC) system using RFID technology.

The main objectives of the project are as follows:

- To automate the collection of toll fees.
- Ensure classification and toll collections are easily reconciled.
- Reduce the manual intervention in toll collection.
- Ensure live tracking and reporting of toll plaza collections.
- To reduce and ultimately eliminate revenue leakage for the government.
- To eliminate queues and congestion.
- This programme is aimed to facilitate seamless movement of vehicles across all tolled roads in Zimbabwe.
- For providing a composite solution on ETC which would take care of the clearing and settlement of electronic toll transaction to make it interoperable and secure.
- To reduce the costs of enforcement using modern and appropriate technology.

##### **In consideration of the above-mentioned project, the Solution provider is expected to:**

- Supply, install, configure and commission an Electronic Toll Collection (ETC) system using RFID technology that is compliant with the Zimbabwean Laws and internationally accepted best practices.
- Link the solution to payment platforms/payment solution providers.
- Allow interoperability with third party systems.
- Integrate with current and future third party systems.
- Provide supporting accessories and technologies required to make the system efficient.
- Train technical, non-technical and support staff.
- Propose a solution that can be integrated with other systems of the government.
- Propose a solution that can analyse data from the surveillance and produce required reports.
