COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT: CLEANING AND HYGIENE SECTORS

Agreement

This agreement made and entered into in accordance with the provisions of the Labour Act [Chapter 28:01] between the Association of Cleaning Companies of Zimbabwe (hereinafter referred to as "the employers' organisation"), on the one part, and Progressive Commercial Trades & Allied Workers Union of Zimbabwe, Fidelity Commercial Trades and Allied Workers Union of Zimbabwe and the Cleaning and Laundry Services Workers Union of Zimbabwe (hereinafter referred to as "the trade union") on the other part, being parties of the National Employment Council for Cleaning and Hygiene Services Industry of Zimbabwe.

This agreement shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st of November, 2023.
